Respondent satisfaction with public, community events

- Most (40%) are neutral/content
 - 30% are "pretty satisfied"

- Most (35%) are neutral content
- 34% unsatisfied / very unsatisfied
 - 28% satisfied

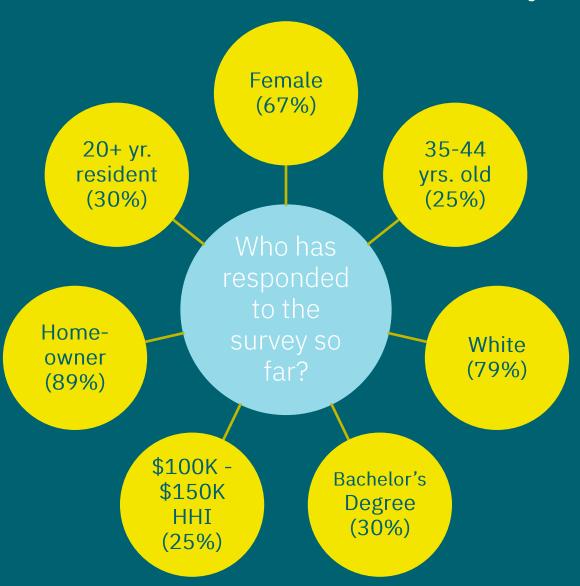

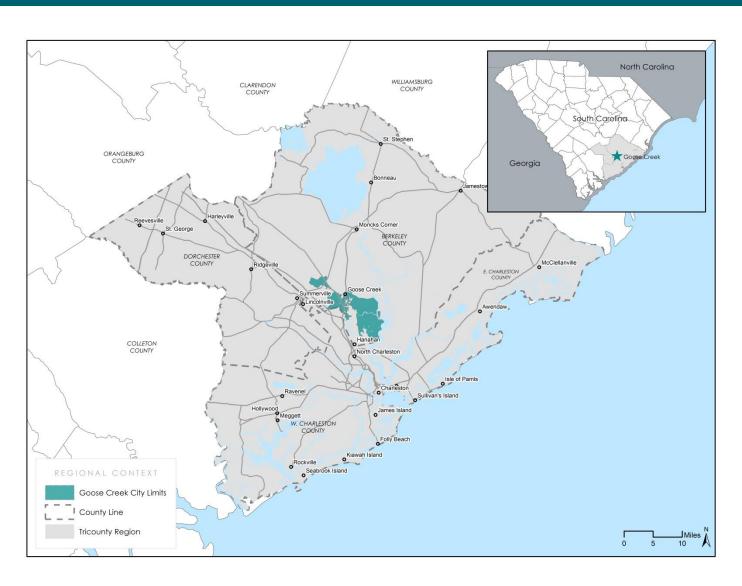

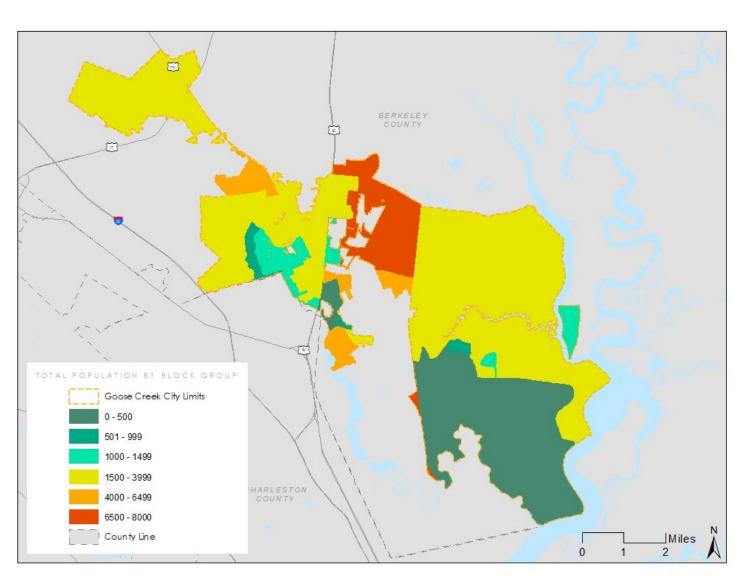
Goose Creek Population Change (2014-2018)

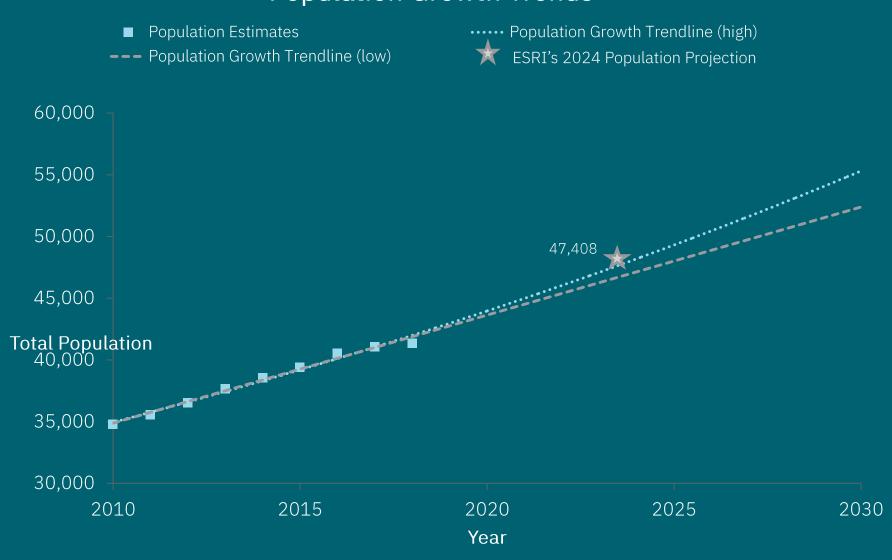

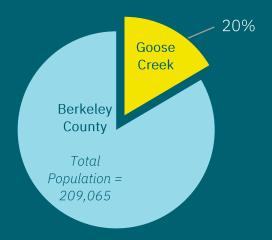

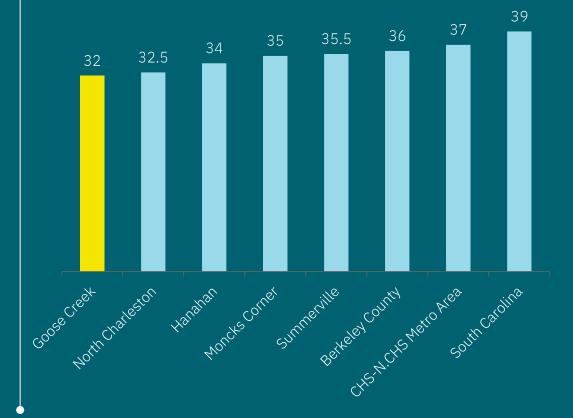




Goose Creek Population as Percentage of Berkeley County's



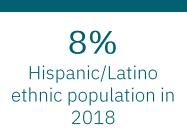
Median Age in Years (2018)

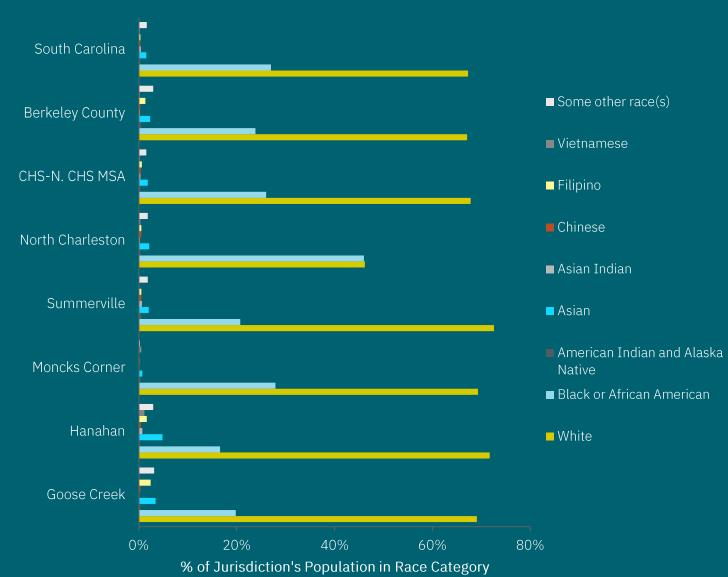

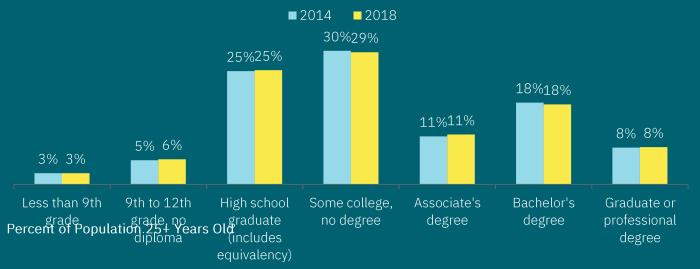




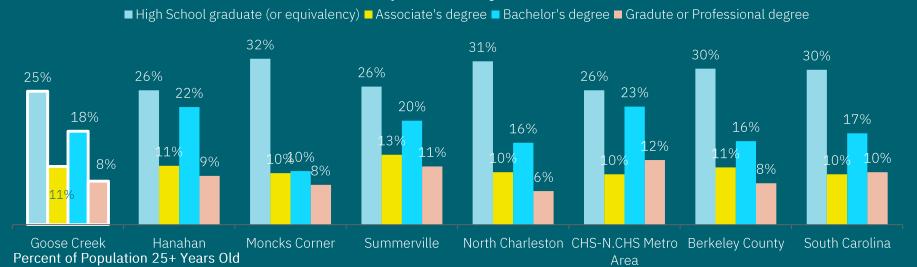

Educational Attainment in Goose Creek

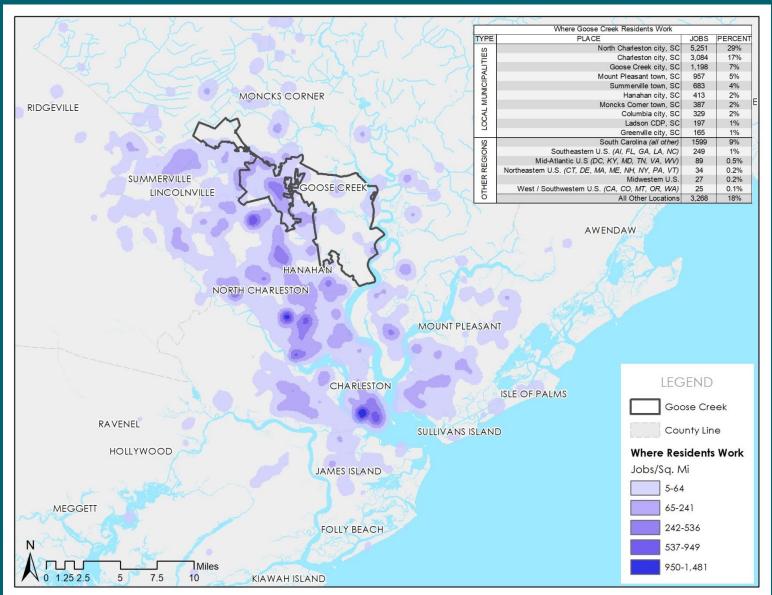


Educational Completion by Jurisdiction (2018)





Work Destination & Job Densities Map



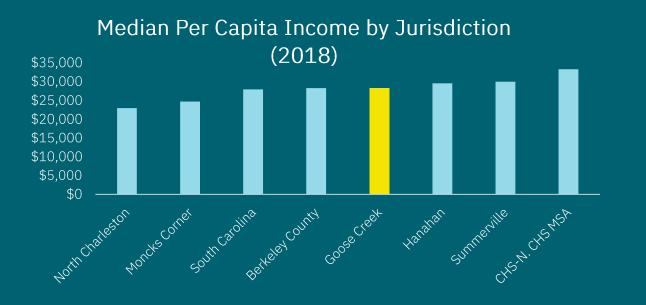


Median Household Income by Jurisdiction (2018)

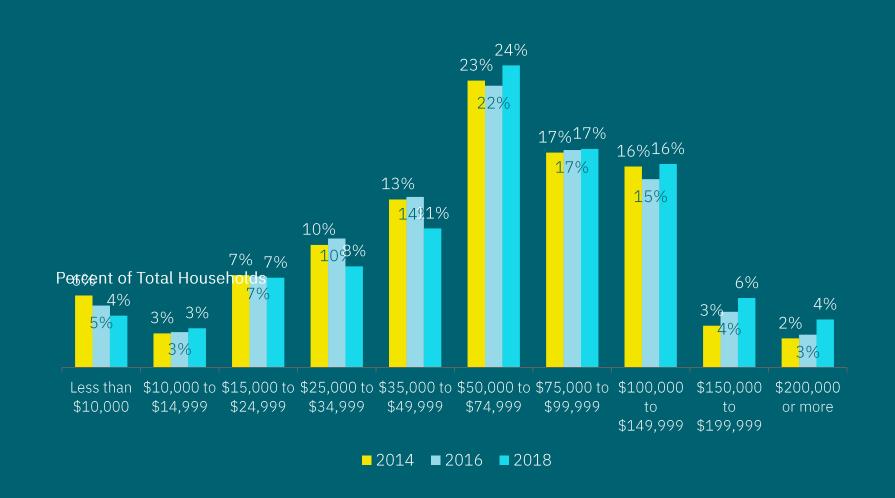

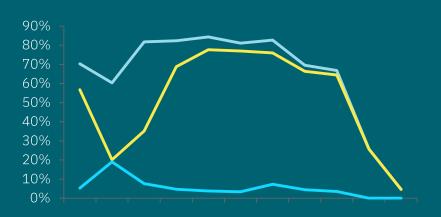

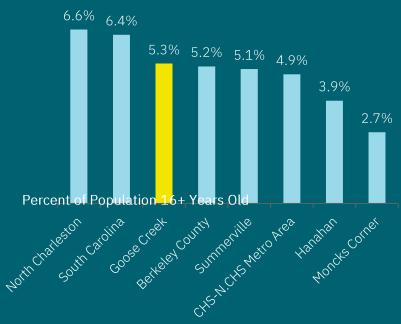

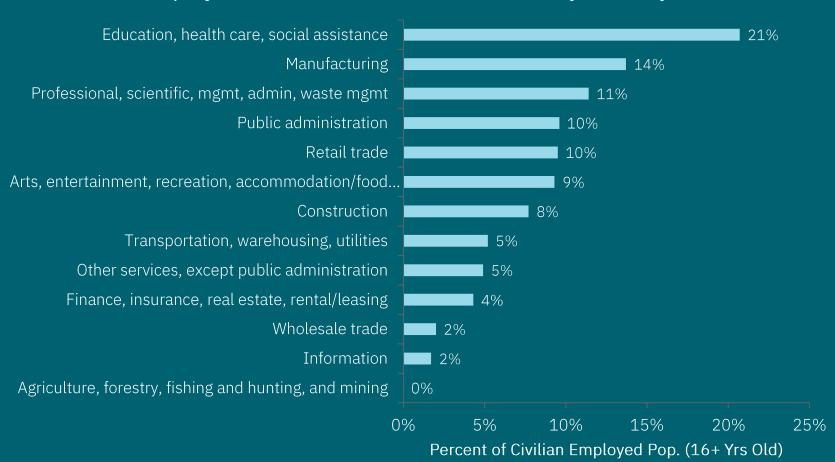
Unemployment Rate by Jurisdiction (2018)



Unemployment steadily decreased from 2013 – 2018, and likely through 2019. The 2020 COVID pandemic will effect this trend going forward.

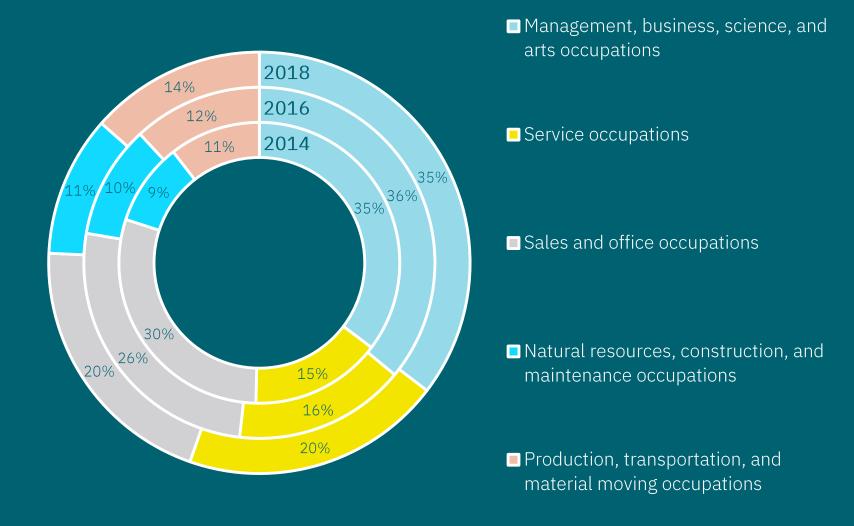


Employment Characteristics of Residents by Industry (2018)



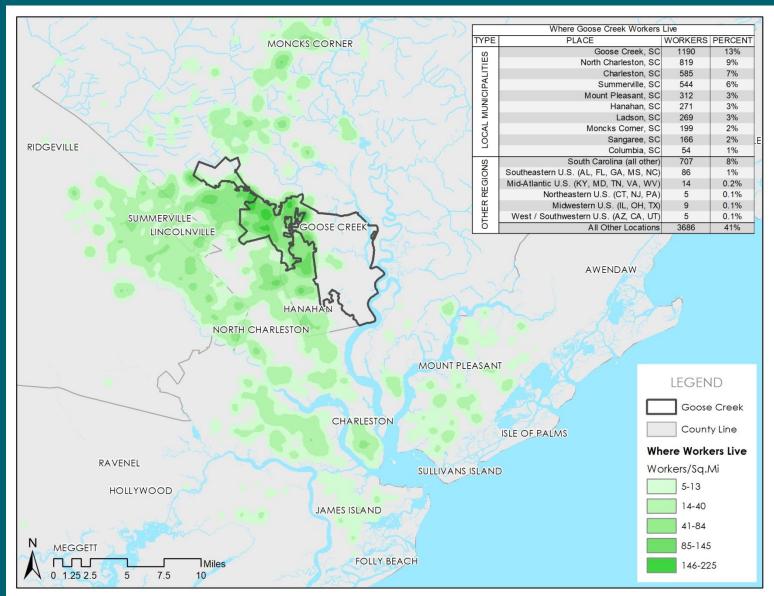


Change in Occupational Characteristics (2014 – 2018)



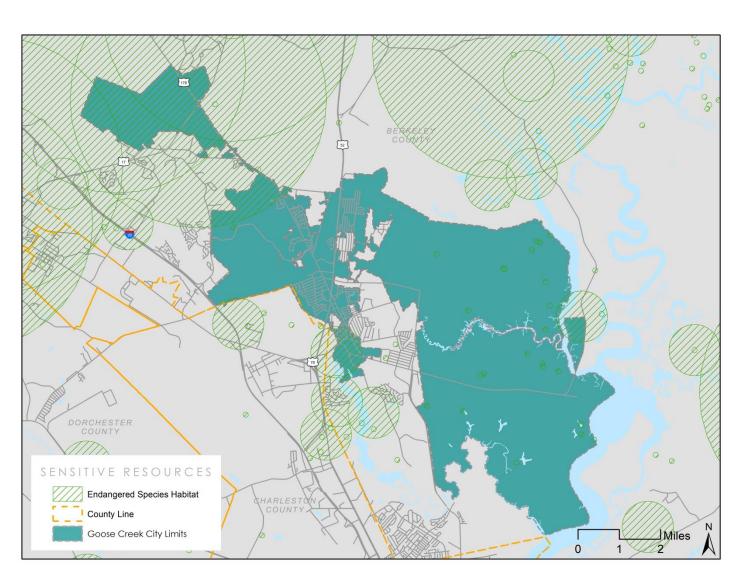


Home Location of Goose Creek Workers Map



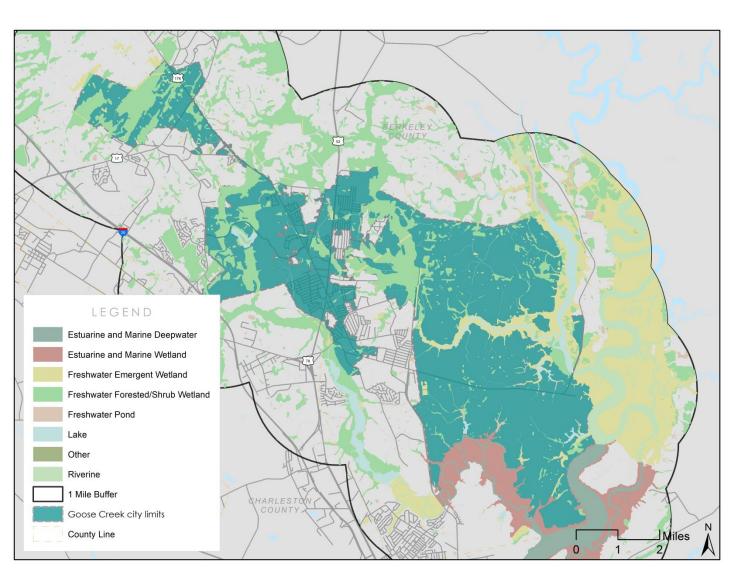


Threatened & Endangered Species Habitats Map



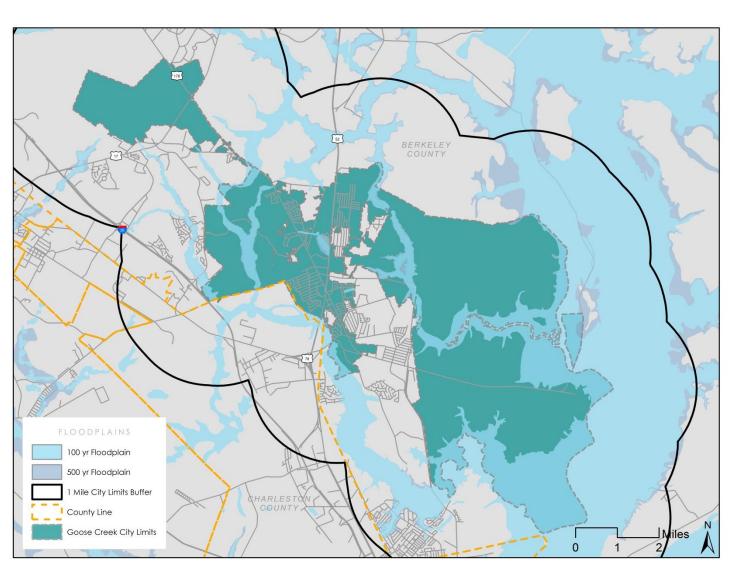

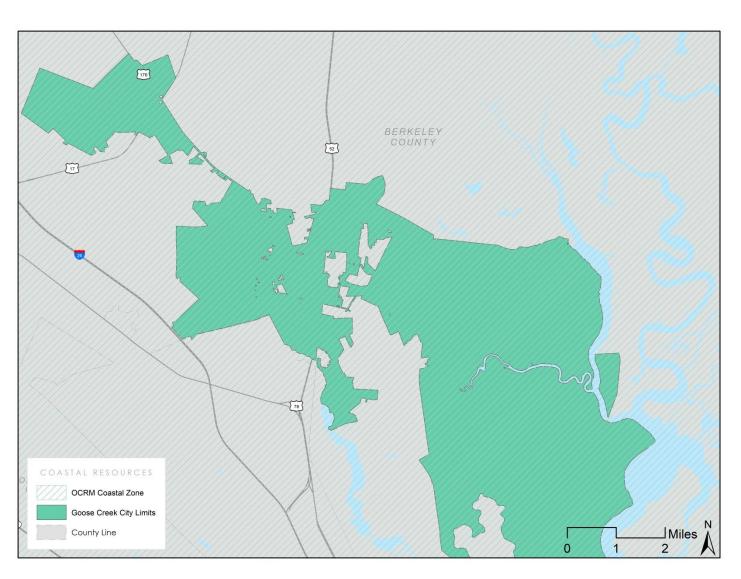

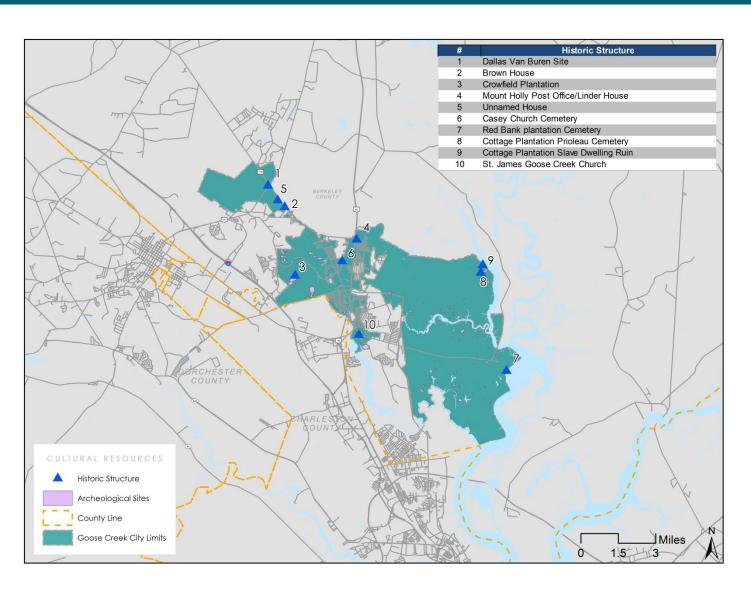

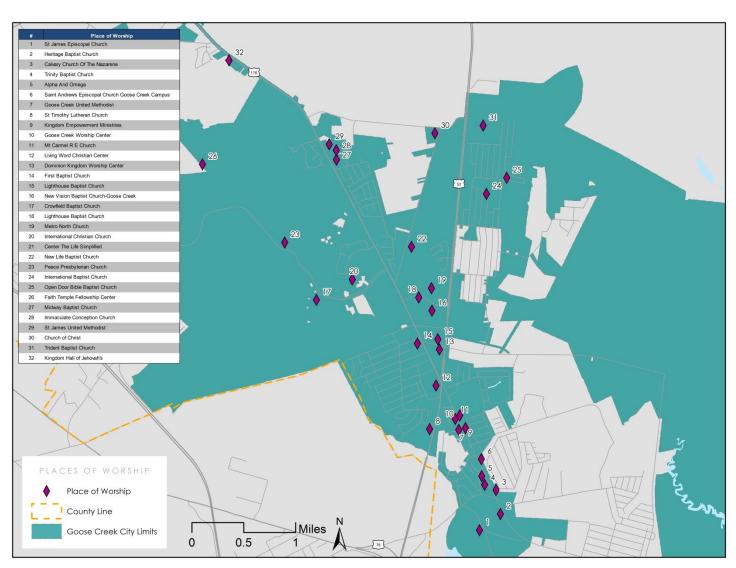

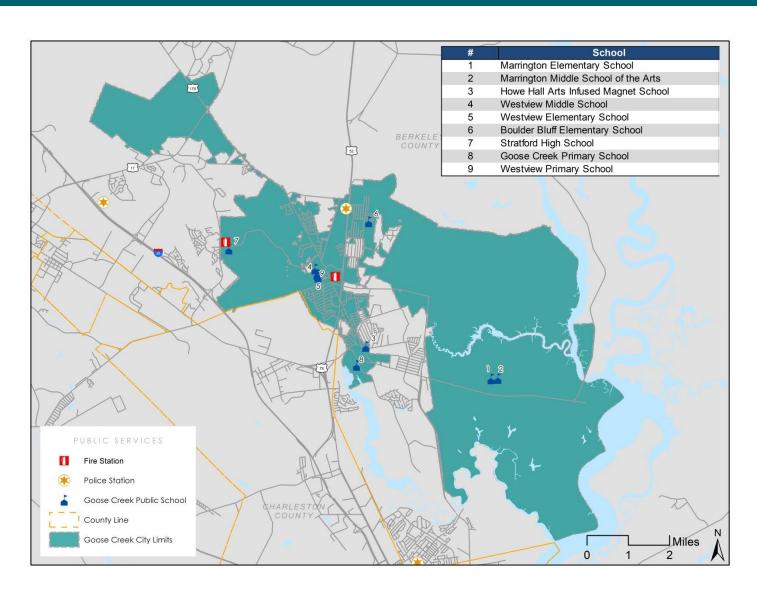

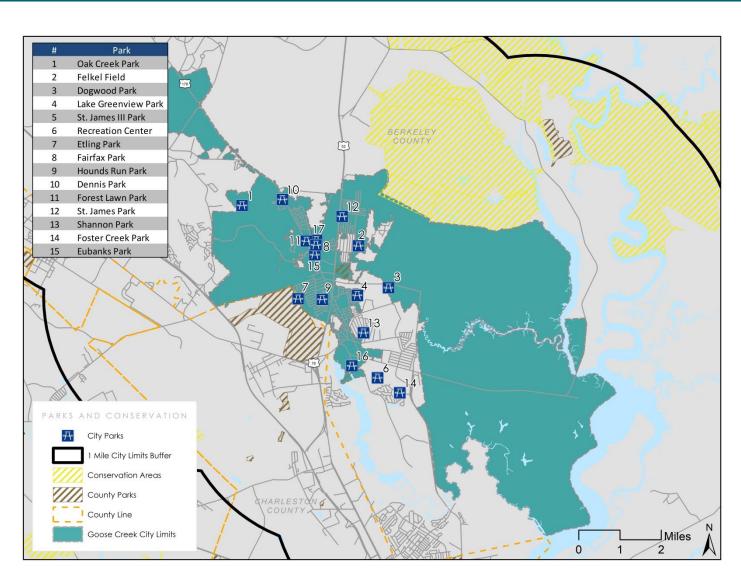

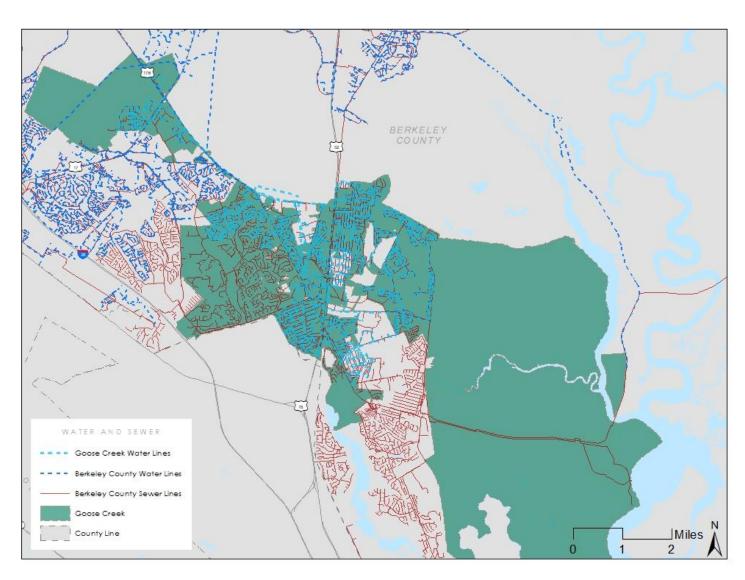


Parks & Open Space Map



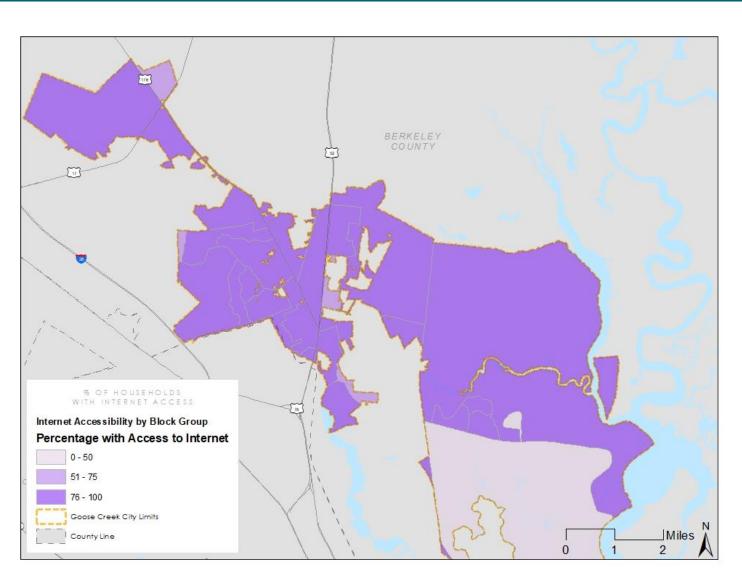

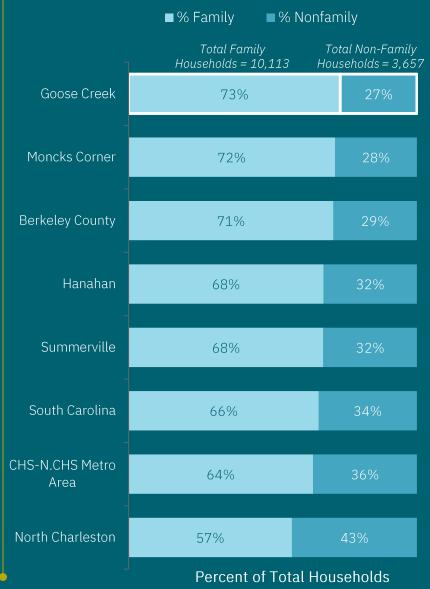

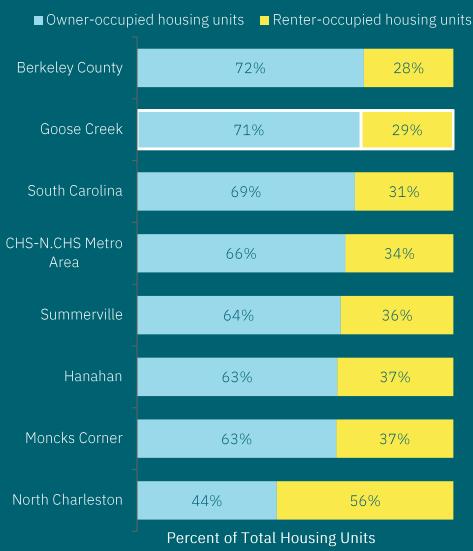

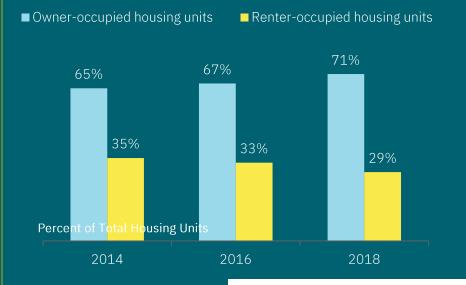

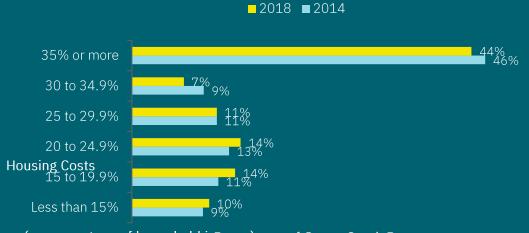

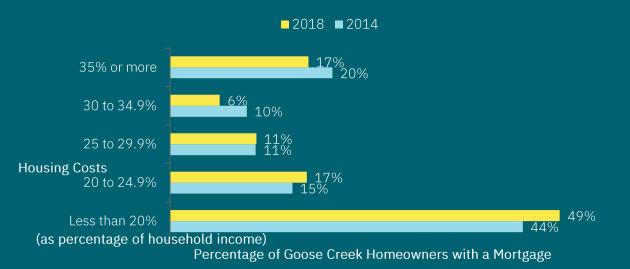

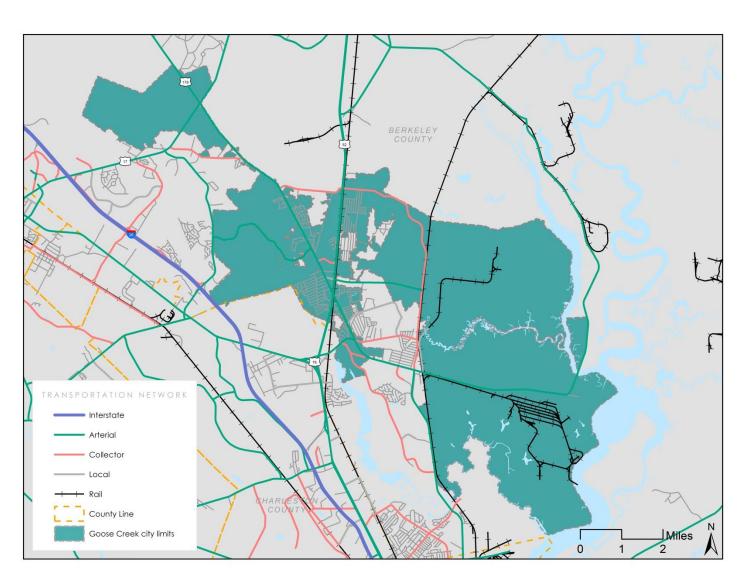
Housing Affordability for Homeowners with a Mortgage



Majority of 2018 housing units were single, detached homes

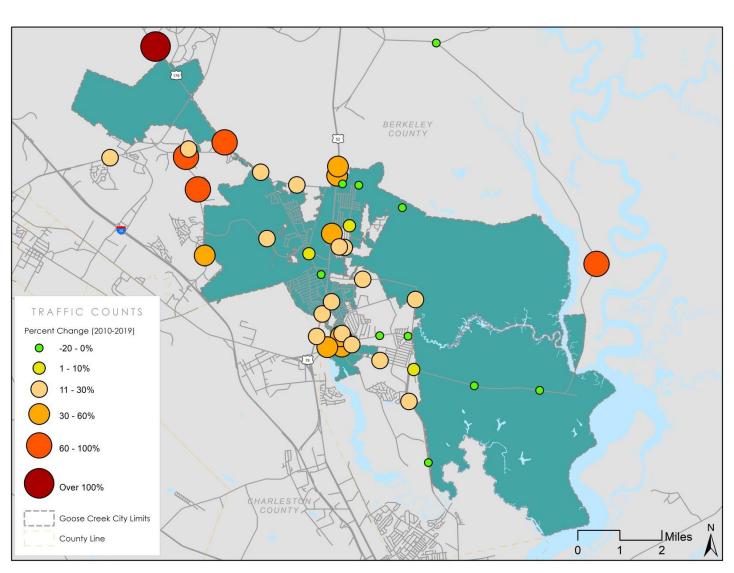


Transportation Network Map



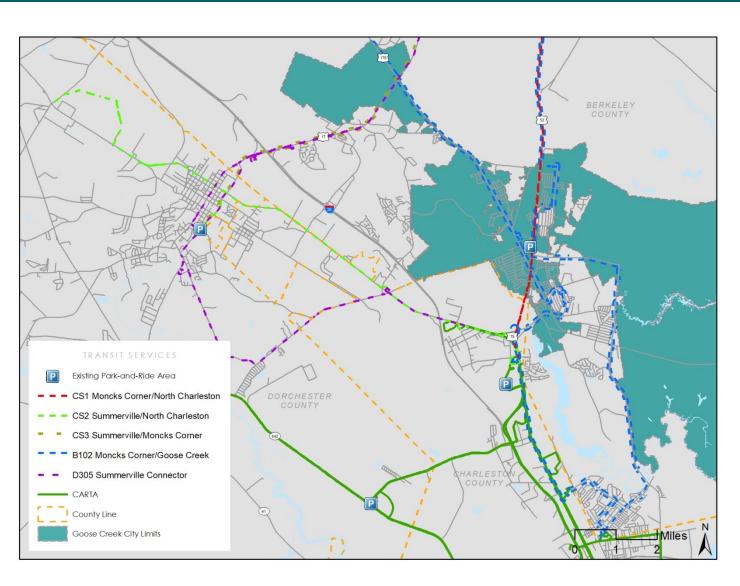


Traffic Counts Map



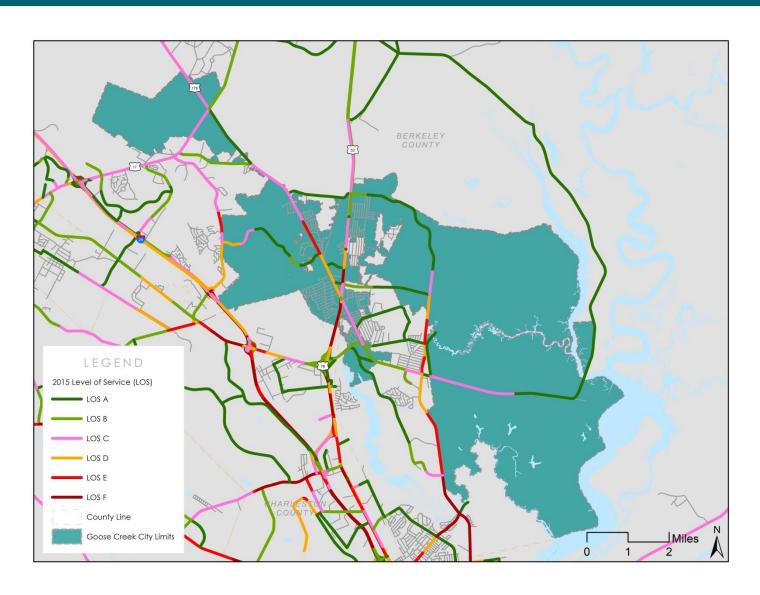


Existing Transit Map



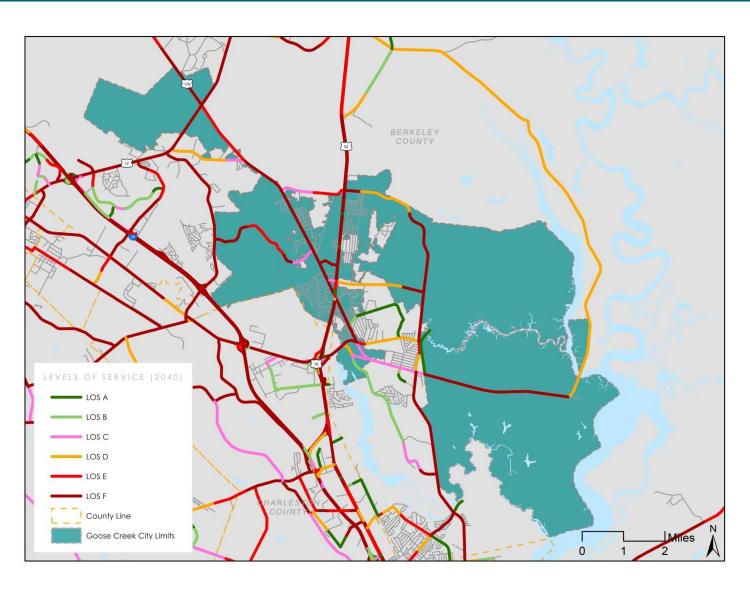


2015 Level of Service (LOS) Map





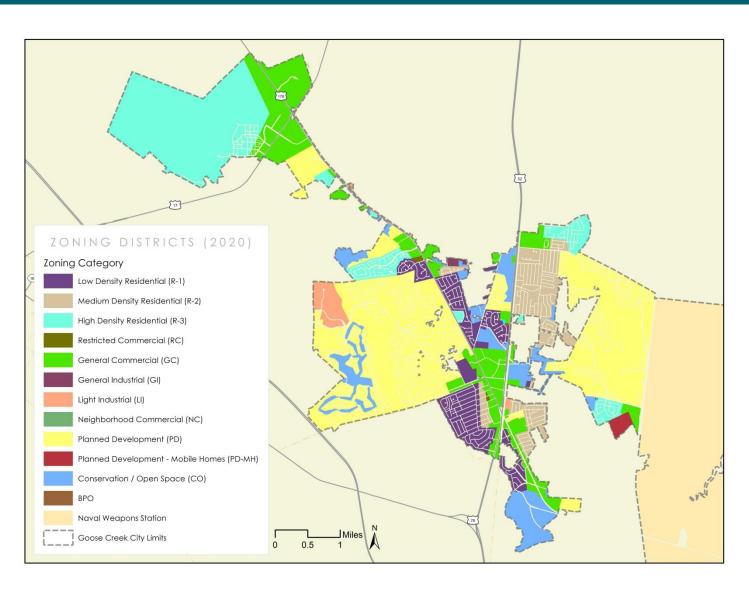
2040 Level of Service (LOS) Map

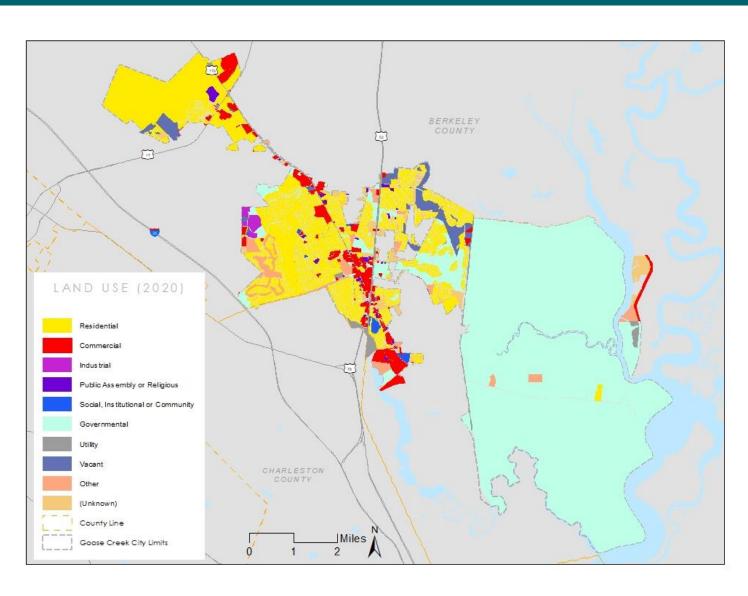
Current Zoning Map (2020)





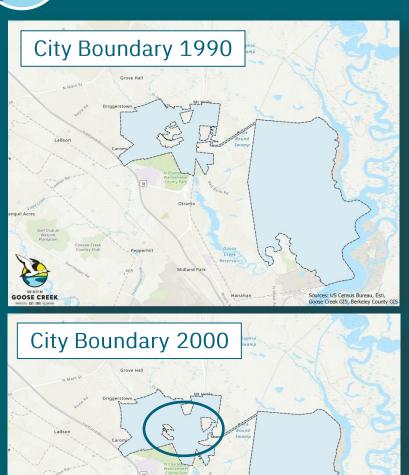

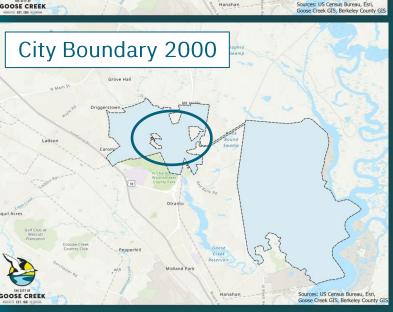

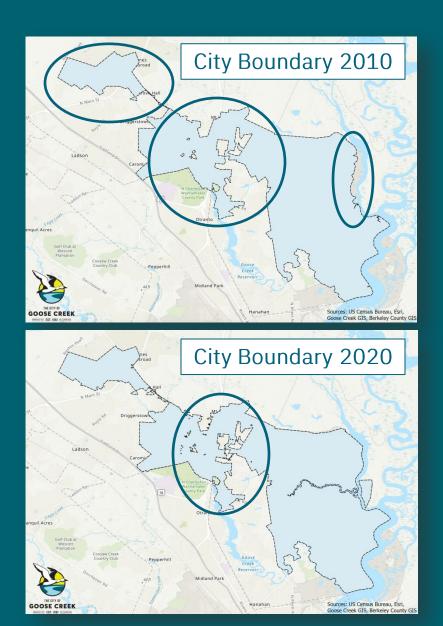

- At what density and where?

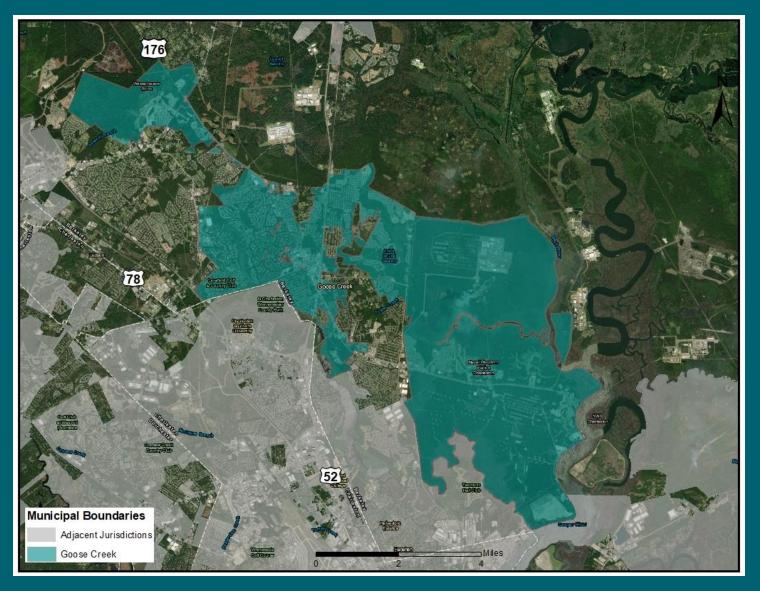
- How might it be developed (e.g. uses)?

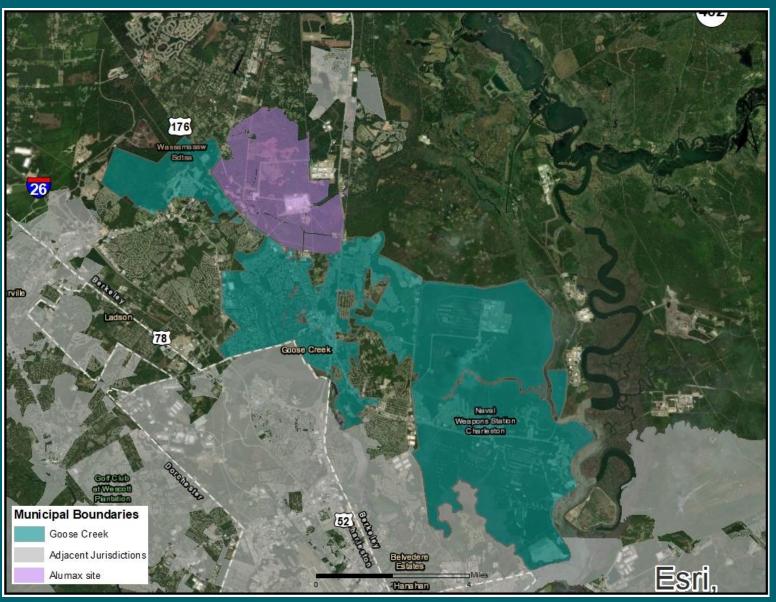

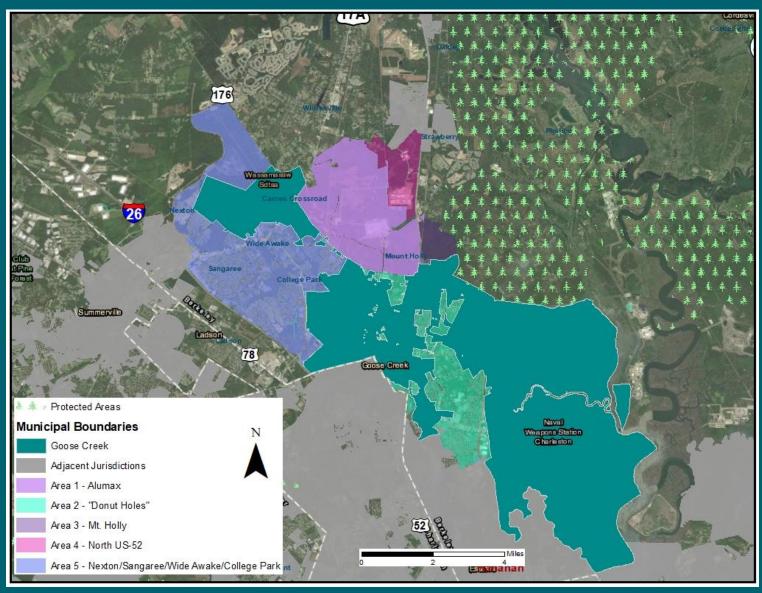
MODERATE EXPANSION

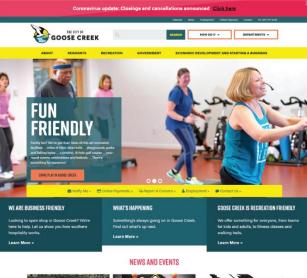

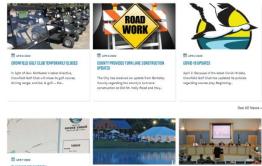
