

Adaptive Tricycle Information

Question: I am looking for more information regarding your Adaptive Tandem Tricycle.

Answer:

- Our adaptive bicycle is available for rental every day of the week Monday-Friday 9:00AM-7:00PM and Saturday & Sunday 8:00AM-5:00PM
- It is free of charge and the responsible party must be at least 21 years old and have a valid drivers license.
- Responsible parties must provide their own helmet for both individuals.
- The equipment usage is good for one hour, per family, per day.
- The responsible party will be required to leave their driver's license at the Community Center.
- A waver must be completed by the responsible party.

Question: Where can I ride?

Answer: You can ride this trike around the pond behind City Hall or on the paved trike trail along 52.

Question: Can I take this trike to another trail?

Answer: Unfortunately, this trike is only to be used at the Pond behind City Hall or the paved trike trail along 52.

Question: Does my child have to know how to ride a trike?

Answer: No. This trike can be 100% controlled by the responsible person in the back.

Question: Do you have helmets for me to rent?

Answer: No, helmets are to be provided by the rider.

Question: How many trikes are available?

Answer: Just one!

Question: How much does this cost?

Answer: This is free to both Residents & Non-Residents of Goose Creek.

Question: Where do I pick up the trike?

Answer: You can complete the proper paperwork along with a tandem tutorial at the Goose Creek Recreation Center (519A North Goose Creek Blvd). This is also where you will return the equipment.

Question: How long do I get the trike?

Answer: The trike can be checked out for one hour at a time. Monday-Friday 9:00AM-7:00PM and Saturday & Sunday 8:00AM-5:00PM

Question: Can I reserve this online?

Answer: No. But someone can register for the **SAME DAY** over the phone.

Trike Information:

- The responsible party is in the back. They are 100% the person who controls the trike. The participant is in the front.
- The individual in the back can control how much foot contribution the person in the front maintains. The person in the front can contribute 0, 1 or 2 (0 meaning nothing, 2 means pedaling just like the person in the back.) If the person in the front pedals, the trike will go faster.
- There are two hand breaks. The circle metal piece is like an emergency break.
- The max load of the two individuals COMBINED is 400 lbs.
- There is a chest plate strap, that is for individuals who do not have sufficient trunk control. This can be removed completely if they have adequate trunk control.
- The seat height at the lowest adjusted seat is at the same height of a wheelchair. You will not transfer any participants, but those in wheelchairs can use this trike.
- The participant in the front, does not have to have control of their hands/arms and or their feet.
- We are the only municipality in SC who has this trike.
- We worked with MUSC & Heathers Ride to fund this trike.
