I. Call to Order

Mr. Buckner called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and confirmed that a quorum was present.

II. Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes

Mr. Bagwell made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Mr. Henderson. The motion was approved unanimously.

III.Activity and Data Update

Mr. Brady discussed the EDAC dashboard with the Committee. Mr. Buckner said he appreciated the consistent data, and that the Committee should continue working to refine updates.

IV. Mission Update

Mr. Tekac gave an update of the mission statement. He said that City Council approved of the latest version, and it will be officially adopted by Council. Mr. Buckner asked that Mr. Tekac occasionally update the Committee about the positive things happening at Council. He said it would be like a monthly education session, wherein the Committee learned something new

about the City. Ms. Gordon mentioned that the Committee should review the website and recommend changes.

V. Membership Discussion

The group discussed membership and the make-up of the committee. Ms. Gordon said that big box stores may not be a good fit because of their unique needs. She mentioned that someone from Crowfield Corporate park should be on the Committee. Mr. Buckner questioned how many total members should serve. Ms. Gordon made a motion to have 11 members, seconded by Mr. Sanchez. The motion passed unanimously. The Committee will discuss precise membership make-up at the next meeting after City Council considers codifying the recommendations. A recommendation was also made to rename the committee the "Economic Development Action Committee."

VI. Chairman's time

Mr. Buckner asked staff to track down any old rules and regulations of the Committee and share them for next time. Mr. Tekac asked all members to let Mr. Brady know if they cannot attend.

Mr. Buckner asked all members of the Committee to send all professional qualifications for chairmanship to Mr. Brady.

Ms. Gordon said it would be best to keep the meetings to one hour or less, allowing for people to attend but get on with the rest of their day.

VII. Adjourn

Hearing no other business, Mr. Sanchez made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ms. Gordon. The motion passed unanimously, and the Committee adjourn at approximately 10:30.
