





- Comprehensive Plan overview:
 - Defines a <u>vision</u>
 - Establishes goals
 - Identifies <u>opportunities and strategies</u>
- City's current Comprehensive Plan adopted in 2010
- City is required to conduct a complete
 Comp Plan update every ten years








WHY SHOULD WE PLAN?


- For example:
 - Population changes





PLANNING AREA SCENARIO 1


MAINTAIN CURRENT CITY BOUNDARIES





PLANNING AREA SCENARIO 2


MODERATE EXPANSION






PLANNING AREA SCENARIO 3
