### COMMISSION MEETING

December 7, 2020

#### **Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 pm by Chairman Jerry Glass.

toward the new park that will be built on the old Casey Center property. It was always the intent to use those funds for a playground for special populations.

Recreation Director Rostin will ask the City to draft a proposal to that effect.

Commissioner Terre inquired if there would be any more benches placed around the lake behind the Municipal Complex.

Recreation Director Rostin stated that is the responsibility of the City but he will mention it to them.

### **New Business**

- Fall sports have finished for the season.
- Winter basketball practices have started; games will begin January 4, 2021.
- Christmas tree lighting ceremony was held Friday, December 4 in front of the Municipal Complex. It was a joint venture with other City departments but was spearheaded by our Events Coordinator. It was well attended and a big success.
- Christmas Parade is scheduled for Saturday, December 12 and we are expecting a great turnout.
- Therapeutic Fishing Tournament was held on Saturday, November 14 with approximately 75 participants. Good turnout this year for this event coordinated by our Therapeutic Coordinator.
- McCants Park is now under construction; we are hoping for a completion date in April or May 2021.
- City Council is swearing in 2 new members and a new Fire Chief has been hired.

Chairman Glass reported that Commissioner Turner has requested she be replaced on the Commission for personal reasons. Chairman Glass has contacted County Councilman Brandon Cox and asked for his assistance in filling this position.

Commissioner Condon opened a discussion about building a small skatepark in Goose Creek. She suggested building one the size of a tennis court.
