



The City of Goose Creek - Department of Public Works is seeking quotes for asphalt repair and parking lot seal coating at our DPW facility at 200 Button Hall Ave.

The scope of this project will include:

- 1.) Approximately 30 square yards of asphalt applied in a 2-inch lift. All areas are to be cut square with all vertical edges tacked to ensure proper bonding. Area to be rolled and compacted and all material that is cut out or removed will be disposed of by the contractor.
- 2. Approximately 230 square yards of asphalt applied in a two 2 inch lifts for a total of 4 inches of asphalt. The area will have the existing asphalt removed and prepped for new asphalt. The vertical edges will be cut straight and tacked. The area will be rolled and compacted flush with the existing asphalt. All debris will be removed by contractor.
- 3.) Approximately 13,500 square yards of parking space will be seal coated. The prepared sealant will be applied at a rate of 5.5 square yards per gallon with sand and hardening additive included and all parking spaces will be restriped. The entire area will be cleaned and swept prior to application. A 1-2 ft. area around the entire site will be cut in to insure a clean and professional finish. Any oil spots will be sealed prior to application. A minimum of 2 coats of sealant will be applied with adequate drying time allowed between coats. Site will be restriped and stenciled upon completion.

Quotes shall be received until 3:00 pm, local time, **June 15, 2018** at the Public Works Complex, 200 Button Hall Blvd., Goose Creek, SC 29445 at which time all quotes will be reviewed for submission to City Council for approval. All quotes shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly. Quotes should list warranty coverage included in the repair.
