Call to Order

Project Status Report

Pool: Mr. Stuber reported the bottom of the kiddie pool has been resurfaced and the chemicals are being re-balanced and it should be re-open this week. Membership sales are slow. Swim lessons have started.

Discussion was held on cross-marketing the pool at other city events.

A suggestion was made to have a City Marquee to advertise events on.

Mayor Heitzler suggested giving free passes to the fitness center and/or pool to new homeowners.

Phase II: Mr. Stuber reported the construction of the new Activity Center is on schedule. Steel work is done, they are pouring the floor and starting on the walls and brick work. Completion date is scheduled for March 2018.

City Swim Meet: We will be hosting this event again this year in conjunction with the Coastal Carolina Aquatics Association. Dates are July 14-16. Eighteen Charleston area swim teams with about 1,000 swimmers will be competing in our pool for the championships. Jennifer Condon is coordinating the meet with help from the staff.

New Business

Parks – Mr. Stuber reported the maintenance crew is working on fertilization and turf maintenance along with pool maintenance. They will also be installing the new football scoreboard at Dogwood Park.

Recreation – Regular season play has concluded for spring sports. All Star tournament play will start June 17. Staff is busy planning for the Fourth of July Festival.

Mayor Heitzler asked about the future of the ballfield at Dennis Park.

Director's Report-Mrs. Greer asked about the grant to replace the playground equipment at Ryan Creek Park. Mr. Stuber stated he has received the grant for \$26,500 and is preparing the paperwork. We also received a grant for St. James.

Discussion was held on future plans for a dog park, a bubble over the pool and a skate park.

Mrs. Heiselman stated we have received donations in memory of Nancy Trevino and asked everyone to be thinking of the best way to honor her.
