Dates and Times:

Session 2: July 15 – July 19 (ages 16-23 years old)

Session 3: July 22 – July 26 (ages 24 and up - seniors welcome)

Where is Camp located?

Monday – Thursday camp will be held at the Goose Creek Community Center (519 A N Goose Creek Blvd.)

Friday (Bonus Day) camp will be held at the pool in the Hamlets at 300 Hamlet Circle, Goose Creek.

Sunscreen, Shower Shoes (optional), Bag lunch, Closed toe shoes (sneakers), Bathing Suit and Towel (for Friday Bonus Day)
